Annual General Body Meeting  
May 20, 2019

The meeting was called to order by President Mitch Sweet at 2:47PM once it was determined that a quorum (40) was present. This meeting was taken out of order with the Vice President of Negotiations giving his report first. John Narcizo gave the VP of Negotiations report, noting how the negotiation team is completing negotiations involving the equity of Appendix D and the department head job descriptions. This motion was seconded by Harold Weymouth, motion passed; three sets of minutes accepted. Karyn Robertson delivered the annual secretary's report. There was a motion made by Jonathan Root to accept the secretary's report, which was seconded by John Knox, motion passed; report accepted.

The president's report was given by Mitch Sweet, which wrapped up the details of the year that weren't mentioned in the previous four reports. The president noted how helpful it has been that our association has a good relationship working with the administration team. Some discussion took place about required remediation. There was a motion to accept the president's report by Gisele Parent, which was seconded by Steve Camara, motion passed; report accepted.
